We invite you to submit a paper and attend the 24th annual research conference on Strategy and the Business Environment (SBE). This conference, which rotates among several top business schools, will be hosted by the University of Virginia's Darden School of Business and sponsored by [Darden's Institute for Business in Society \(IBIS\)](#) and the [UVA Miller Center for the Presidency and Policy](#). The conference will be held on May 3rd and 4th, 2024 at Darden's Sands Family Grounds, Darden's Washington DC area facility at 1100 Wilson Blvd in Rosslyn, VA. Meals are included for all registered attendees.

The conference explores the interrelationships between the business strategies of firms/industries and the social, legal, and political environments in which they operate. We are receptive to a wide range of research perspectives and methodologies, including formal theoretical modeling, quantitative empirical research, and qualitative research, in either developed or developing economies. Papers drawn from economics, political science, sociology, strategic management, and related fields are appropriate for the conference.
